For this school year only, the State Department of Education has allowed districts to treat "snow days" as distance learning days. CTECS has decided to take advantage of this option in order to keep our students engaged. If there is a need for a snow day, CTECS will treat the day as if we were in our Phase 4, Distance Learning protocol. Your children will distance learn from home as they have been doing this school year in our hybrid model of learning. Teachers and students will continue to login as scheduled for classes.

There may be instances where we do choose to close entirely. This would occur if there are widespread power/internet outages impacting teachers and students ability to connect remotely. Your building principal will announce ahead of time if it is a distance learning day or a closure.
