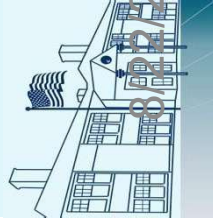

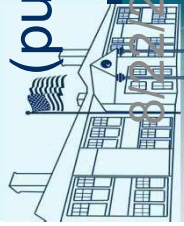
Social Contracts Vs. Setting Expectations

CLASSROOM/SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS

- Teacher/adult driven/stock (Done “TO”)
- Rule based: “PROVIDED”
- ‘RESPECT’ seen as meaningful (Used as if it is literally understood)
- Fixed in time (add or subtract items as needed)
- Context blind (cookie cutter)
- Violations seen as requiring (punitive) consequences

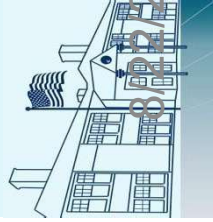
SOCIAL CONTRACTS

- Community driven/individualized (Done “WITH”)
- Relationship based: “OWNED”
- ‘RESPECT’ is unpacked (Items listed on SC is what RESPECT looks, feels & sounds like)
- Living and breathing (edit and amend with community)
- Context dependent (agreement)
- Violations seen as opportunities to educate and repair

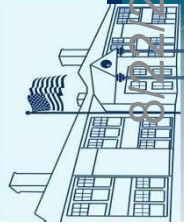

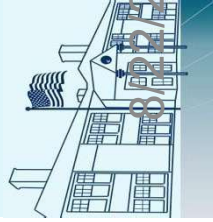

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS



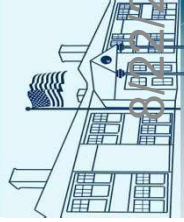
Some students out of the starting gate will not be able to comply with classroom expectations because....

- Stay with our class

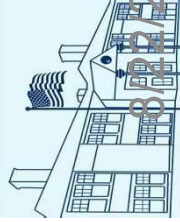

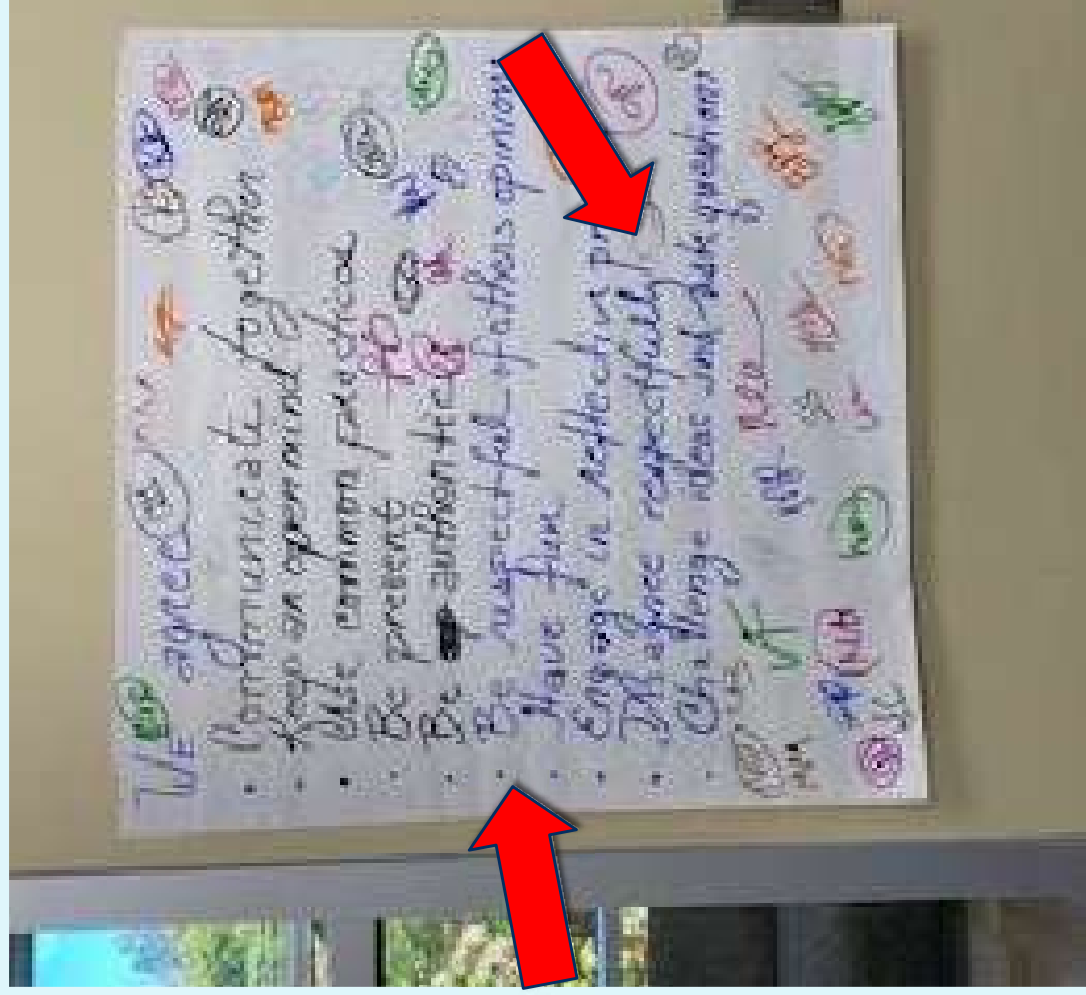


‘RESPECT’ does appear on Social Contracts, but it is made clear that everything else on the Social Contract is what ‘RESPECT’ looks, feels and sounds like

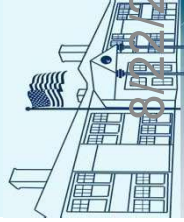
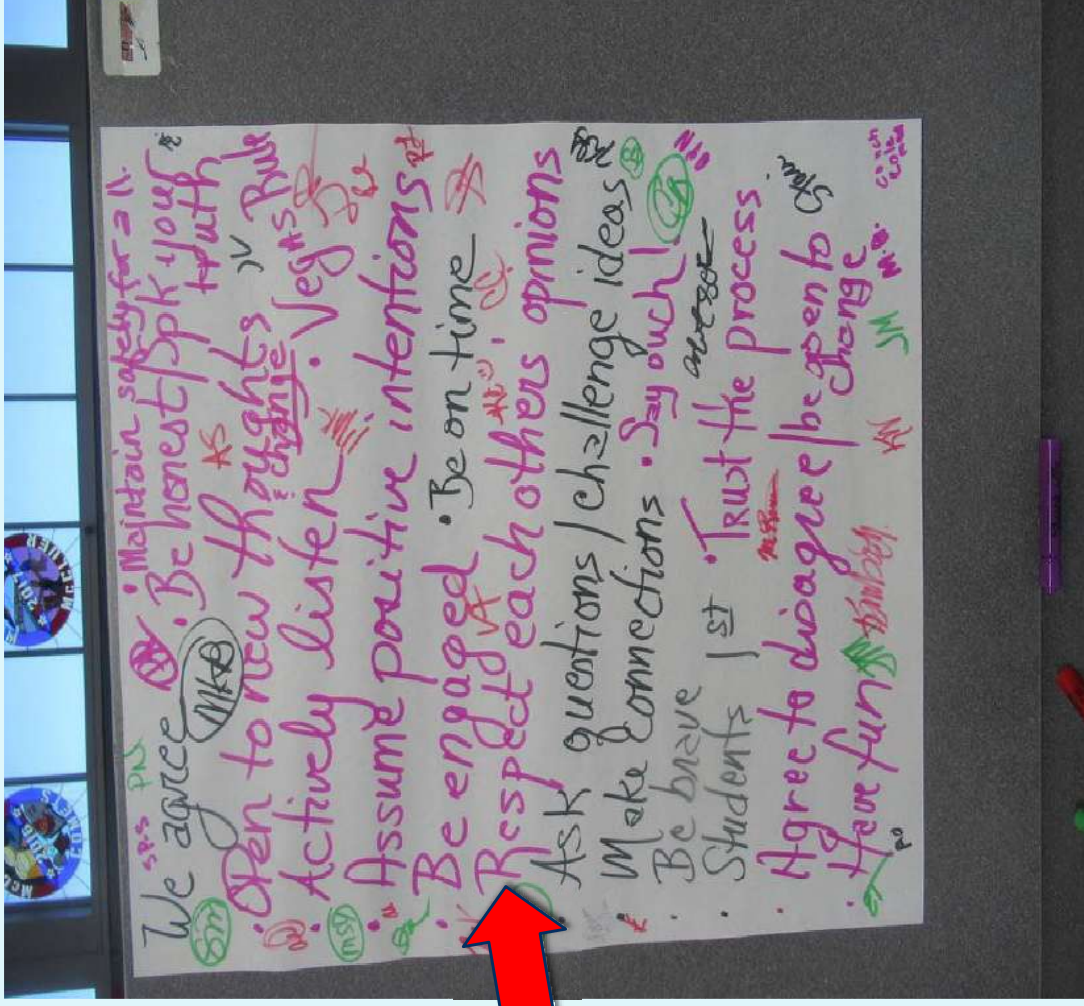
